

Obtain permission to change your vehicle's colour

If you wish to change your car's colour, you'll need first to obtain a permission from a Salama centre. Failure to do so, will result in a traffic fine.

To get your permission, you'll need to do the following:

- Drive to any Salama centre
- You will not need vehicle inspection, so don't position yourself in the queue; You also don't need to go inside and get a ticket from the counter
- Simply park your car and go to the supervisor's office
- Please note that if the car had an accident, the supervisor will not be able to give you the permission without a valid SAAD / Police report
- Please also note that such permissions are issued only to the car owner; you will need to **come in person** in order to do this procedure
- Once the permission is granted, please proceed to the cashier to get your permission certificate; You will need to pay AED 40.
- Now you can proceed to any garage and change the colour of your car

Once the colour change has been completed at the garage, you will need to issue a new registration for your car that reflects the new colour.

- Drive back to Salama and contact the supervisor
- The supervisor will check and if all approved you'll need to pay another AED 40 at the counter for the 'colour test'
- After your 'colour test' certificate is issued, proceed to the Police Counter to get a new registration card issued. [Click here](#) to see a list of our Salama centres that have a Police Registration Office on-site
